David's Harp Foundation

Mission: To inspire, educate and empower system affect and homeless youth to achieve academic success through music education, sound engineering and multimedia production. David's Harp Foundation differs from our other agencies in that they connect to young people with challenges (homeless, lack of academic achievement, and behavioral issues) through music. So instead of purchasing food, clothing, etc they need high tech multimedia equipment. This agency is really making a difference, in particular, through their outreach programs in Juvenile Detention Facilities.

Purchase: Various Audiovisual equipment such as a digital camera, stand grip arm, GoPro HERO7 and recording monitor.

Amount: \$3000

Transitional Youth Academy (TYA) Oceanside

Mission: Provides long-term case management, academic mentoring, and leadership development to at-risk youth in Oceanside. This program helps youth finish high school, gain employment, be supported by a mentor, and receive training in life skills. Provides behavioral health assessments and counseling. Provides career development, social, and vocational case management services. Offers career assessment, apprenticeship placements, and financial literacy training. Provides tutoring and job search assistance. Provides referrals to academic training including opportunities to earn a high school diploma or GED. Offers family support, parent-engagement activities, basic needs, and self-sufficiency services and referrals.

Purchase: Various items to help clients return to work or school. Laptops, employment attire, sometimes baby items for single/new mothers.

Amount: \$2500
