### 1) Kid's Turn San Diego

**Mission:** Created in 1996 to bring peace to families who could no longer communicate without conflict. With a mission of “promoting supporting and securing the well-being of children who are experiencing family separation”, our programs empower children to talk with their parents about thoughts/feelings, build resiliency and create a brighter future for children experiencing family separations, divorces and military transitions.

**Purchase:** Supplies and books to support their ongoing counseling sessions. FOCUS made a similar grant last year. Please note that this agency has researched and listed every item needed, complete with sourcing and prices to assist our shopper.

**AMOUNT:** \$2,096.00

### 2) Vista Hill Therapeutic Learning Center (TLC)

**Mission:** Request is to support ParentCare Family Recovery Center which is one of Vista Hill's longest running programs serving over 200 families each year within two sites. An important part of ParentCare is the on-site specialized pre-school and childcare services in their Therapeutic Learning Center (TLC). These services are provided for parents involved in the ParentCare program that could otherwise not afford childcare to attend sessions. Educational and motor-skill development is provided. In addition TLC staff is specially trained in trauma-informed methods and are able to provide additional emotional and behavioral support to children that may have experienced traumatic events.

**Purchase:** Everyday consumables like diapers, wipes, creams as well as specific motor skills equipment and educational items. FOCUS made a similar grant last year. Please see the attached letter outlining their request.
