Some of the agencies we help are growing and becoming very successful in their mission and in their ability to fund raise. Projects is always searching for non-profit agencies that are just starting up and will benefit from FOCUS help. Membership approved the following Projects for April.

ECS / Episcopal Community Services

Mission: ECSis dedicated to providing free, bi-lingual behavioral health services to low-income / high potential children , ages 0 - 5 years old. 100% Of children served are low-income, more than 50% have experienced trama due to child abuse, neglect, accidents or serious illness and 25% have experienced or witnessed domestic violence. **Requested:** 20 Chromebooks to connect families to trauma-focused therapy and support groups. The devices will also connect families with housing, healthcare, food assistance and additional services.

Amount: \$5,400

Traveling Stories

Mission: Traveling Stories works to change the idea of reading from being a chore to an indulgence, especially for reluctant readers, by creating a space where books and reading are fun. The main goal of Traveling stories is to provide literacy support, mentorship and goal setting. The current Virtual Story Tent program awards pretend "Book Bucks" for every book read during the program. With more than 80 kids registered in the program, getting ready to place their orders, Traveling stories is asking FOCUS to help provide "prizes".
