F.O.C.U.S. SALUTES AND SUPPORTS SAN DIEGO MILITARY FAMILIES

San Diego is home to 110,000 active-duty military personnel and more than 118,000 of their family members. However, due to the high cost of living in San Diego and recent inflation, many of these families are struggling. Here's some surprising stats. Currently there are 45,000 service members who go to the food bank every single month to put food on the table. Along with that the military child care waitlist is 4,000 spots long!



FOCUS is well aware of some of the challenges facing, in particular, junior enlisted military families. So, last Thursday night, FOCUS saluted and celebrated all the great work being done by several local agencies at an event held at the famous Top Gun IBAR at Naval Air Station North Island. The event was called, "Salute to the Military" and was attended by over 70 FOCUS members and other guests. In attendance were representatives from six local agencies: Armed Services YMCA, Support the Enlisted Project (STEP), San Diego Military Outreach Mission (SD MOM), Navy and Marine Corps Relief Society (NMCRS), Foundation for Women Warriors (FWW) and United Through Reading (UTR).



It was a wonderful evening full of gratitude and tribute to all of those who have and currently serve and an opportunity for guests to talk and learn more about the missions and programs of each of these agencies that provide a "social safety net" to young sailors and marines when they experience financial and other types of emergencies. There was much mingling of guests with flight-suited "real life" Tom Cruises along with lots of selfies taken among the hanging beer steins and squadron memorabilia. With an open bar and delicious "all you can eat" taco buffet, folks were sated enough to listen attentively to a short program where each agency's mission and programs, along with how FOCUS has supported each agency was highlighted. Then because they are in the midst of a huge \$6.5M expansion campaign, the CEO of STEP, Tony Teravainen, a former Navy submariner spoke a few minutes about what this campaign will do to expand STEP's services to military families.



FOCUS' next big event will be their annual fundraiser/gala on July 13,2024 held on the USS MIDWAY Museum. This year's theme is "Light Up the Night" and it guarantees to be an amazing summer evening filled with live music, gourmet dinner, Live and Silent Auction, Raffle and "Raise the Paddle".
