"EL NIDO" WHICH MEANS "THE NEST" IN SPANISH, IS A TRANSITIONAL HOUSING SHELTER OPERATED BY INTERFAITH SHELTER AGENCY. IT HOUSES WOMEN AND CHILDREN WHO ARE ESCAPING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. IN SEPTEMBER, FOCUS PURCHASED A "TON" OF DIAPERS, WIPES, TOYS AND OTHER ITEMS TO EL NIDO TO HELP SUPPORT THESE NEEDY FAMILIES. FAMILIES ARE SUPPORTED WITH A CASE MANAGER AND SHELTER UNTIL THEY ARE ABLE TO "GRADUATE" TO PERMANENT HOUSING.

FOCUS SUPPORTING "LARGE PROJECTS" IN 2024. As you hopefully noticed last month when you voted on September projects, FOCUS can afford this year to support several LARGE projects (meaning \$20-\$40k). Last month you approved supporting \$25,000 to help repair the roof of transitional housing for young people of David's Harp Foundation AND \$20,000 to support the facility expansion project of Support the Enlisted Project (STEP). Both of these agencies are SO APPRECIATIVE of our support to these projects that will make a big difference in supporting their mission.


