By giving needed items to San Diego County disadvantaged, disabled and military children either directly or through accredited organizations that support them.




### What's the Word?



The Friends of Children United Society (FOCUS) traces its origins to early 1982 in Coronado, California. A national organization known as WAIF (founded by actress Jane Russell) served as a source of inspiration to a group of dedicated and highly motivated women in the Coronado Cays to found FOCUS. From WAIF to FOCUS reflects a number of changes and associations with organizations like The Travelers' Aid Society and Friends of Travelers before becoming the locally wellknown and highly respected organization now known as FOCUS. The FOCUS name was created by Bobbe Cetti and the original logo was designed by Ruth Friedman.

The motivation and drive of the women involved in creating FOCUS was centered on improving the quality of life for needy and abused children in San Diego County. This commitment and the pressing needs of children continued and FOCUS evolved to meet the ever-growing challenge. In 2009, FOCUS became more inclusive with the invitation to men to join our membership. Advances in technology required FOCUS to adapt and enhanced communication methods with the establishment of a website and Facebook link. The additional association with Amazon Smile provided a means of funding and membership involvement.

Through increased membership, the success of major fundraisers and countywide recognition, FOCUS has broadened its scope with fulfillment of larger requests, year round grants, vehicle purchases and the more critical, urgent needs of our charity partners. Because of our members and all who have contributed their expertise, finances, and services to the organization, FOCUS continues the original mission to assist the needy children of San Diego County today.
